ECML Webinar: Opportunities and Challenges for Plurilingual and Intercultural Education in Times of AI

Purpose:

This webinar aims to help language professionals understand the impact of AI on plurilingual and intercultural education and to strengthen democratic culture through critical examination of AI opportunities and challenges in language teaching.

Short description:

A webinar organised by the European Centre for Modern Languages (ECML) of the Council of Europe, facilitated by Jonas Erin, ECML expert from the French Ministry of National Education. The session takes a critical look at AI in education, exploring both opportunities and challenges for language education. It incorporates Council of Europe/ECML tools to support teachers in adapting to technological changes while maintaining focus on democratic values and intercultural competence.

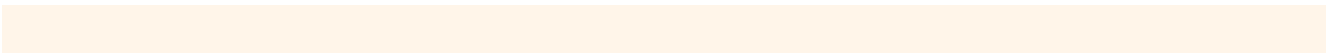
